









Total Tons & Per Capita Rate for Texas Municipal Solid Waste, 2015




Construction Waste by Weight

- Light fixtures
- Doors
- Windows
- Toilets
- Tubs
- Reclaimed wood
- Ceiling Fans



Reuse with some help:

- Built-in cabinets
- Broken mirrors
- Water-damaged furniture



Recycle into something else:

- Broken granite
- Gypsum
- shingles



DECONSTRUCTION & RESALE CHALLENGES

- Broken things
- Mold
- The time it takes to restore an item that needs work is often not monetarily worth it
 - i.e. spending 30 minutes denailing a piece of wood you'll sell for \$7.50
- Requires a LARGE space to hold the items until customers are ready to buy them... There's a buyer for everything. They just may not be here today.
- Customers may need x of something but you have x-1...
